

REPORT

Present: C. Bachmann, J.R. Bonham, J.L. Dhondt, A.H. van Gennip, P.P. Kamoun, J.L. Willems, L.J.M. Spaapen Excuses from: Mrs. P. Divry, B. François, J.M.F. Trijbels.

Wistorical milestones:

- December 1991 establishment of ERNDIM: PUROPEAN RESEARCH NETWORK FOR EVALUATION AND IMPROVEMENT OF SCREENING, DIAGNOSIS, AND TREATMENT OF INHERITED DISORDERS OF METABOLISM.
 January, 1992: initiative of Baudouin François for a concerted action to join the expertise in the various European countries in the field of the screening, diagnostics, and therapy of inherited disorders of metabolism (IDM). This resulted in submission of the ERNDIM-I project to the Biomedical and Health Research Programme (BIOMED-I) of the European Community.
- The ERNDIM-I proposal was not qualified for subsidization; to ambitious, to extensive (to many topics), and to many participants.
- End of 1992: collaboration of the two Biochemical Genetics Centres of twin universities of Belgian's and Netherlands Limburg to work out a new proposal for BIOMED. This ERNDIM-II project was restricted to the development and execution of a European Quality Assurance Program (QAP) for biochemical genetics laboratories.
- February, 1993 submission of the ERNDIM-II proposal.

FIRST MEETING OF THE ERNDIM European Research Network for evaluation and improvement of screening, diagnosis and treatment of inherited disorders of metabolism.
